The new ADVANCED tariff offers standard AC and DC prices throughout Germany with reduced blocking fees, which are identical at all charging points.

With the PRO tariff, drivers can enjoy all the benefits of the ADVANCED tariff combined with an affordable IONITY package. The right choice for frequent drivers who often want to charge quickly and cheaply on the road.

This gives every customer the option to find the tariff that best suits their individual charging needs. All tariffs can be canceled on a monthly basis. This allows customers to quickly switch between tariff options to meet their changing needs. With standard prices at over 100,000 charging points in Germany, LOGPAY creates transparency and reliability for its customers.
